



Tree Planting

On the Friday 17th March, we are planting 400 trees from the Woodland Trust and 85 from Rotherham United. We are creating a 'Tiny Forest' to improve the biodiversity of our school grounds and create a connection between the children and the natural world.

Your child will need a pair of wellies and a waterproof coat to wear when they plant the tree. In a bid to help save the planet from more waste, they will also need to bring a cup in a bag with their name on so they can enjoy a hot chocolate or an orange juice once they have done the hard work. It can be any cup but please send one that you do not mind being potentially broken.

Below are the ingredients of the hot chocolate and orange juice. Please let school know if you would prefer your child not to have either of these drinks.

Ingredients:

Hot Chocolate

Whey Powder (Milk), Sugar, Maltodextrin, Fat-Reduced Cocoa Powder* (12%), Glucose Syrup, Coconut Fat, Lactose (Milk), Thickener (Xanthan Gum), Stabilisers (Polyphosphates, Potassium Phosphates), Milk Protein, Anti-Caking Agent (Calcium Phosphates), Emulsifiers (Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids, Mono- and Diacetyl Tartaric Acid Esters of Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids), *Rainforest Alliance Certified

Orange Squash

Water, Comminuted Orange from Concentrate (18%), Citric Acid, Acidity Regulator (Sodium Citrates), Flavourings, Sweeteners (Acesulfame K, Sucralose), Preservatives (Potassium Sorbate, Sodium **Metabisulphite**), Stabiliser (Carboxy Methyl Cellulose), Antioxidant (Ascorbic Acid), Colour (Carotenes)
