# Celebrating the incredible life of Mrs Morley

On Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November, we will be celebrating the life of Mrs Morley. Sheila was a former dinner lady and volunteer at our school for over 30 years. Sheila had a strong sense of fun, loved the community of a party and very much had a spirit of adventure. At her funeral, the family gave out glow bands and asked that the congregation wore bright colours.

All members of the school community are welcome to come in glowing/ bright/fluorescent colours (black can be worn as a contrast with glowing colours on top). Throughout the day, we will be promoting ways that we can make a positive contribution and make the most of life like Mrs Morley did.

- Tickets must be bought in advance and will be available on the KS2 playground at breaktime from Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November.
- All children must be collected at 4:30pm from the hall by an adult. (If your child regularly attends Rainbow Club we will discuss arrangements with you.)
- The £3.00 cost of the ticket covers after school entry and DJ, childcare, a drink, biscuit, crisps and a glow stick.
- During the disco, we will also be selling ice pops, sweets and additional drinks. Please send your child with some small change to buy any items.
- Please note As this is an after-school event, any child with poor behaviour will not be able to purchase a ticket.

The focus of the events will be celebrating like Mrs Morley would have wanted. Her family will be there too. Any profits raised will be split between school and Rotherham Hospice.
