Spring 1 Home Learning

Expected Learning

Reading	We expect that the children read a minimum of three times a week to an adult or older sibling. Please record this in their planner. Children achieve 3 dojos for reading three times in a week. Every Wednesday the children will choose a new library book to take home. Please ensure they have this book ready to swap on a Wednesday. Spend time, perhaps at bedtime, looking through the book together and talking about the pictures, predicting what might happen next and perhaps spotting some tricky words within the text.
Literacy	This term we will be learning, by heart, a fiction text called 'The Naught Bus' by Jan Oke. This is a recommended approach to support writing from the Talk for Writing method. A script and story map will be sent home, please spend time helping your child learn the story.
Mathematics	Continue spotting numbers in the environment and subitising amounts without counting. Can you find smaller numbers within larger numbers? Set the table at home or have a teddy's tea party and work out whether you need 1 more or 1 less knife or fork. Compare the height or length of your toys and put them smallest to largest. Put your family in order shortest to tallest. Compare length of feet – who has the longest feet in your family?

Additional Curriculum Task

Please choose at least one item from the menu below and bring the home learning into school by the end of the half term. This task can be done with adults. Children can choose more than one if they wish. The more creative the better!

- ⇒ **Create** a form of transport out of recycled materials for your teddy or yourself!
- ⇒ **Draw** a picture of what the Naughty Bus might get up to.
- ⇒ **Take** a trip in a form of public transport and take pictures.
- ⇒ **Design** a route for a bus or car and draw a map.
- ⇒ **Visit** the library and look at books about transport – tell us what you found out.
