Ongoing ideas to do at home:

Encourage your child to be more independent. Let them try to put on their shoes themselves before helping them. You may be surprised what they can do independently	Encourage your child to wait for their turn while at the park or in a conversation. Play turn taking games with your child such as snap. "My turn, your turn."
While making dinner, how many forks do we need to set the table? Can your child count out the forks to set the table?	While on a walk, can you spot some different signs of spring? Look at the flowers growing and changing each day if you pass.
Take your child to a new place with some new people to enable them to gain confidence.	Comment on your child's play and build on their language, "I see you are using the red car today"

Things to try at home:

Do you have some farm animals at home? Can you set up your own farm? We have been using Weetabix and shreddies to make our own sensory tray.

Can you make some different farm animal sounds for your family to guess?

Can you make your own small Dingle Dangle Scarecrow using old clothes?
