### FS2 Summer 1 Home Learning

#### Expected Learning

<b>Reading</b>	<p>We expect that the children read a minimum of three times a week to an adult or older sibling. Please record this in their planner.</p> <p>Children achieve 3 dojos for reading three times in a week. Your child will continue to bring home their weekly phonics book.</p> <p>Every Wednesday the children will choose a new library book to take home. Please ensure they have this book ready to swap on a Wednesday. Spend time, perhaps at bedtime, looking through the book together and talking about the pictures, predicting what might happen next and spotting some tricky words within the text. In addition to this, please practise any flashcards and tricky words that have been sent home.</p>
<b>Literacy</b>	<p>This term we will be learning, by heart, Handa's Surprise. This is a recommended approach to support writing from the Talk for Writing method. A script and text map will be sent home, please spend time helping your child learn the story. Feel free to send videos of your child retelling the story via dojo, they love sharing these with their friends in class.</p>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<p>In maths we will continue to develop a concrete understanding of composition of number and bonds of number 1-10. Look at amounts of objects within 10 and discuss what numbers they are made up of.</p> <p>Compare the height of each member of the family or find out who has the longest foot.</p>

#### Additional Curriculum Task

Please choose at least one item from the menu below and bring the home learning into school by . This task can be done with adults. Children can choose more than one if they wish. The more creative the better!

- Draw a picture and label a Safari animal e.g. lion, giraffe, monkey, elephant, crocodile.
- Find 3 fascinating facts about a Safari animal.
- Make a model using recycled materials of a Safari animal.
- Create a tally chart of your family's favourite fruit.
- Discuss and compare the weather, animals and fruit in Africa and the UK.
