All about Me



Ongoing ideas to do at home:

Encourage your child to be independent and make their own choices. Can you give them a choice while getting ready - "Can you carry your bag today?" "What top would you like to wear today?"	Collect some items from around the house. Can your child tell you what the items are? Can they remember where they live in your house?
Introducing sitting on the toilet between nappy changes.	Making lines, circles and swirls in a tray of flour/salt with your fingers. Make your own gloop (cornflour and a little water) to mark make in.
Try to cut down on time having their dummy. If your child is trying to talk, remove their dummy.	Giving your child time to talk. Sing nursery rhymes, share bedtime stories and chat about what you are doing during the day.
Encourage your child to walk independently rather than in a pram for short walks.	Begin to talk about feeling happy, sad, angry. "I can see you're feeling a bit angry right now"

Things to try at home:

- Have a look in the mirror, talk about the differences you see. Do you have the same colour hair? Are you wearing glasses or not?
- Can you use some items around the house to make a face?
- Have a walk to the park/woods. Can you collect all things autumn (leaves, twigs, conkers) to bring in to REY for our activities.
- Can you sort these items into different colours? How many are brown? Are they all the **same** shape?
