### Autumn 2 Home Learning

#### Expected Learning

Reading	We expect that the children read a minimum of three times a week to an adult or older sibling. Please record this in their planner. Children achieve 3 dojos for reading three times in a week. This half term your child will start bringing home a phonics book. Every Wednesday the children will choose a new library book to take home. Please ensure they have this book ready to swap on a Wednesday. Spend time, perhaps at bedtime, looking through the book together and talking about the pictures, predicting what might happen next and spotting some tricky words within the text.
Literacy	This term we will be learning, by heart, a version of the story 'The Gingerbread Man.' This is a recommended approach to support writing from the Talk for Writing method. A script and story map will be sent home, please spend time helping your child learn the story.
Mathematics	Spend time subitising (noticing numbers) in the world around you. Encourage them to notice amounts up to 5 without counting and looking for smaller numbers within amounts up to 8. Encourage children to look for patterns and shapes in the natural world.

#### Additional Curriculum Task

Please choose at least one item from the menu below and bring the home learning into school by **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December**. This task can be done with adults. Children can choose more than one if they wish. The more creative the better!

- Draw patterns linked to Diwali or Bonfire Night using chalk, crayon or paint.
- Can you draw or make a pattern using different 2-D shapes?
- Retell the story of the Gingerbread man using actions.
- What is your favourite toy? Why? Talk to a grown up about their favourite toys when they were a child.
- Race your favourite toy cars and see which moves the fastest.
- Listen to a piece of music and talk about how it makes you feel.
- Use body percussion to create your own sounds.

- Pete the cat and his new shoes
- Julian is a mermaid
- 10 little superheroes
