



Attendance and Lateness

The Trust attendance target is **97**%, the national average is **95.1**% and our School attendance so far this year is **93.1%**.

205 hours of learning has been missed so far this year due to lateness which has become a concern as children are missing valuable learning time. It is vital children are in school on time everyday. The school day starts at 8:40 KS2 and Y2 and 8:45 for Year 1 and Reception.

We know that the cold weather is having an impact on children's health. They should be in school as much as possible so that they are achieving the best outcomes. Attached is a letter from the NHS to help you determine if your child is well enough to come to school or not.



Please help us to help you by:

- Try to telephone, email or use the In app messaging service before 8.30am each day of your child's absence.
- Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.
- Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance, talk to us as a first step so we can help!

Breakfast Club

Every day, we offer breakfast club for our children from 7.45am.

Rainbows

Every day, we offer after school childcare. This is across in our REY building.

- Home time to 4:30 Children have a light snack e.g. toast £5.50
- Home time to 5:30 Children have a bigger snack e.g. beans on toast £10
- On a Friday, Rainbows offers Forest School Friday until 4:30 where the children take part in outside activities too e.g. cooking on a campfire, den building, scavenger hunts.

Cashless

We are now cashless school and any payments must be made through Arbor.

Lunch Supervision and Dinners

All school meals should be paid for in advance on Arbor. Huge thanks to the vast majority of parents who do this.

Parking

The zig zag lines outside of school are there to protect our children and not to be parked across.

Please can we remind you the car park is for staff use only and should be used under no circumstances unless agreed in an emergency.

Reading

All children are expected to read 3 times per week and parents must write in the reading diaries for the teachers to check.
