## Spring 2 Home Learning

### Expected Learning

Reading	We expect that the children read a minimum of three times a week to an adult or older sibling. Please record this in their planner. Children achieve 5 house points for reading three times in a week.
Spelling	All children have spellings to learn each week. These are sent home in a booklet at the start of each half term. Please make sure that your child practices. 5 minutes, three times a week will make a huge difference. Your child can also learn their spellings on the online website spelling frame (details in diaries). They are given at the start of term and are tested on a Monday.
Mathematics	Children need to practice their number facts regularly. Little and often is the key to getting these embedded. In Year 1, we expect the children to practise their number facts using the online website NumBots. Please do this at least 5 days a week for 5 minutes. Children will also be sent home a Maths worksheet.

### Additional Curriculum Task (optional)

Please choose at least one item from the menu below and bring the home learning into school by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March. This task can be done with adults. Children can choose more than one if they wish. The more creative the better!

- Go on a walk and write a list of the plants and trees you see. You could research if they are deciduous or evergreen.
- Draw and label your favourite plant or tree.
- Draw a map of the local area and mark on your route to school.
- Use a tablet to draw a picture using the skills you have learnt in computing.
- Design a garden for the house of your dreams.
