Spring 2 Home Learning

Expected Learning

Reading	We ask that children read a minimum of three times a week at home. Please record this in their home/school planner. Children achieve 5 house points for reading three times a week, and we have a class reading reward in place as an incentive to do this.
Spelling	All children have spellings to learn each week. These are recorded in their planner. Please make sure that your child practises these at home on a separate piece of paper. Children will be tested every Friday.
Mathematics	Children need to practise number facts regularly (eg. multiples, doubles, halves, number bonds). We have found that little and often is the key to getting these embedded. In Year 4, we expect children to practise their target times tables on TTRockstars. Children must complete 30 minutes weekly.

Additional Curriculum Task

Below are some examples of home learning your child may choose to complete. Please choose at least one idea and bring the home learning into school at the end of the topic. This task can be supported by adults. Children can choose more than one if they wish. The more creative the better!

- Create a poster or model which explains how, why and where the Vikings travelled
- Create a Viking shield, ship, or artefact
- Write your own journey tale using one of our toolkits – action, dialogue, suspense
- Create a spreadsheet of costs for a birthday party
