Ongoing ideas to do at home:

Can your child follow rules at home? Encourage your child to tidy up their toys at home before moving onto the next activity. We are encouraging "Choose it, use it, put it

Can your child help you with chopping up some fruit for a snack? Can they hold the knife safely with one hand?

Encourage your child to walk independently for the short distances that you may usually use a pram.

When picking your child's clothes, can you talk about the patterns you can see? Are they wearing striped socks? Can they hunt around the house for other pattern items?

Share a bedtime story with your child. When you have read the story - can your child talk about what has happened. "Who went to the shops?"

Encourage your child to be more independent. Let them try to put on their shoes themselves before helping them. You may be surprised what they can do independently.

Things to try at home:

Share some grapes or other foods, do you have the same amount, more or less?

Have a look through some items from your house—do they feel heavy or light?

Socks are light but a tin of beans is heavy.

Can you create a paper plate jungle animal?
