FS2 Summer 2 Home Learning

Expected Learning

Reading	We expect that the children read a minimum of three times a week to an adult or older sibling. Please record this in their planner. Children achieve 3 dojos for reading three times in a week. Your child will continue to bring home their weekly phonics book. Every Wednesday the children will choose a new library book to take home. Please ensure they have this book ready to swap on a Wednesday. Spend time, perhaps at bedtime, looking through the book together and talking about the pictures, predicting what might happen next and spotting some tricky words within the text.
Literacy	This term we will be comparing Kenya to the UK and learning the story of Handa's Surprise. We will continue to use the Talk for Writing method. A script and story map will be sent home, please spend time helping your child learn the story.
Mathematics	Spend time practicing counting confidently to 20 and beyond. Practice one more and one less with numbers up to 10. Copy, continue and repeat patterns. Identify odd and even numbers up to 10.
